- Reduce exclusionary zoning.
- Ban source-of-income discrimination.
- Expand the Low Income Housing Tax Credit program and Capital Magnet fund.
- Create a \$7.5 billion per-year grant program four housing with supportive services.
- Reform federal housing tax incentives.
