SENATOR MICHAEL BENNET (D-CO), a 2020 presidential candidate, has released key proposals and goals to address the affordable housing crisis.

SENATOR MICHAEL BENNET'S AFFORDABLE HOUSING PROPOSAL INCLUDES:

- Build more affordable homes for the lowest-income people through an investment of \$400 billion over ten years in the national Housing Trust Fund.
- Increase the supply of opportunity housing vouchers to meet the full demand for all eligible families within 15 years.
- Reduce exclusionary zoning.
- Ban source-of-income discrimination.
- Expand the Low Income Housing Tax Credit program and Capital Magnet fund.
- Create a \$7.5 billion per-year grant program for housing with supportive services.
- Reform federal housing tax incentives.
